



**V LETU 2024 V TRIGLAVSKEM NARODNEM PARKU, NA OBMOČJU JULIJSKIH ALP IN V CELOTNEM SLOVENSKEM NARAVOVARSTVU OBELEŽUJEMO 100-LETNICO PODPISA ZAKUPNE POGODBE ZA USTANOVITEV ALPSKEGA VARSTVENEGA PARKA, PREDHODNIKA TRIGLAVSKEGA NARODNEGA PARKA, KI POTEKA POD ČASTNIM POKROVITELJSTVOM PREDSEDNICE REPUBLIKE SLOVENIJE DR. NATAŠE PIRC MUSAR.**

IN 2024, TRIGLAV NATIONAL PARK, THE JULIAN ALPS REGION AND NATURE CONSERVATION IN SLOVENIA JOINTLY COMMEMORATE THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SIGNING OF THE LEASE AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH THE ALPINE CONSERVATION PARK, THE PREDECESSOR OF TRIGLAV NATIONAL PARK, WITH THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA, DR. NATAŠA PIRC MUSAR, AS ITS HONORARY PATRON.

**V**arstvo je obstoj. Geslo ob praznovanju 100. obletnice ustanovitve predhodnika Triglavskega narodnega parka razumem najprej kot veliko hvalježnost, da so naši predniki prepoznali pomen varstva dela prelepih Julijskih Alp. In nato kot zavezo in odgovornost, da spoštujemo izjemno naravo Triglavskega narodnega parka, ki nam je zaupana v varstvo za rodove, ki prihajajo za nami.

Naravovarstveni začetki za ohranitev izjemnih naravnih danosti območja okoli Triglava segajo v začetek 20. stoletja in sovpadajo s pobudami v Evropi za ohranitev naravnih znamenitosti pred škodljivimi vplivi človeka na naravo v industrijski dobi. Z vsakoletnimi Belarjevimi dnevi počastimo spomin na pobudnika zavarovanja doline Triglavskih jezer in dela Julijskih Alp, ki danes tvori

Triglavski narodni park, naravoslovca Albina Belarja. S prvotnih 1400 hektarjev Alpskega varstvenega parka v Dolini Triglavskih jezer je zavarovano območje sčasoma zrastle na današnjih skoraj 84.000 hektarjev. Območje Triglavskega narodnega parka tako sestavlja kar štiri odstotke slovenskega ozemlja.

Številni dogodki v letu, ko zaznamujemo 100. obletnico vzpostavitve prvega zavarovanega območja v Sloveniji, naj služijo za krepitev zavesti, da ostaja ključ za ohranjanje bogastva narave in raznolikih ekosistemov Triglavskega narodnega parka tudi danes v naših rokah. Tamkajšnji prebivalci živijo v sozvočju z naravo, ki jih obdaja, in upoštevajo bogato kulturno dediščino kot temelj sonaravnega razvoja. Prav vsi obiskovalci naravnih lepot Julijskih Alp pa moramo biti obzirni turisti, ki upoštevamo pravila odgovornega obiskovanja našega prelepega naravnega bisera.

Upam, da vas koledar dogodkov spodbudi k obisku enega ali celo več dogodkov med letošnjim jubilejnim letom, ki ga namenjamo poglobljajnu znanja o bogati zgodovini ter izjemni raznolikosti naravne in kulturne krajine parka.



**Protecting is existing. To me, the slogan of the 100th anniversary of the establishment of the predecessor of Triglav National Park is, first and foremost, an expression of gratitude to our ancestors who recognized the importance of preserving a part of the stunning Julian Alps. It is also a sign of commitment and responsibility to respect the outstanding nature of Triglav National Park we are entrusted to safeguard for the generations to come.**

*The first conservation efforts*

*aimed at protecting the exceptional natural features of the area around Mt. Triglav date back to the early 20th century and coincide with European initiatives to preserve natural landmarks from the harmful effects of human activity during the industrial era. Belar Days are held annually to honor the memory of the natural scientist Albin Belar, the person who initiated the protection of the Triglav Lakes Valley and a part of the Julian Alps, which now form Triglav National Park. From the original 1400 hectares of the Alpine Conservation Park in the Triglav Lakes Valley, the protected area has grown to nearly 84,000 hectares today and Triglav National Park now takes up four percent of Slovenia's territory.*

*Numerous events held throughout the year that marks the 100th anniversary of the founding of the first protected area in Slovenia should strengthen our conviction that we*

*hold the key to preserving nature's riches and the diverse ecosystems of Triglav National Park. The area's residents live in harmony with the surrounding nature and value the rich cultural heritage as the foundation of sustainable development. When visiting the stunning natural features of the Julian Alps, we must strive to be considerate guests of nature, consistently following the rules that apply to responsible visitor use.*

*I hope that as you flip through the events calendar, you will decide to attend at least one of the events commemorating this year's anniversary, which will be dedicated to strengthening the knowledge about the extraordinary history and diversity of the park's natural and cultural landscape.*

JANEZ BIZJAK

Janez Bizjak je arhitekt, naravovarstvenik, publicist in nekdanji dolgoletni direktor Javnega zavoda Triglavski narodni park.  
Janez Bizjak is an architect, conservationist, publicist and a former long-term director of Triglav National Park.

**P**o ustanovitvi prvega narodnega parka na svetu leta 1872 v dolini Yellowstone v ZDA so bile podobne ideje o posebnem varstvu neokrnjene narave v Alpah po takratnem splošnem prepričanju razumljene kot nepotrebna norost.

Pionir novega vala na takratnem Kranjskem, svetovno znani seizmolog in izumitelj dr. Albin Belar, je že leta 1906 za Deželno vlado Kranjske pripravil strokovni katalog, v katerem je za naravne spomenike predlagal Ljubljansko barje, Dolino Triglavskih jezer, območje Snežnika in Krakovski gozd, dve leti zatem pa posredoval še predlog za razglasitev *Naravovarstvenega parka nad Komarčo* (v Dolini Triglavskih jezer).

Ko so v Ljubljani leta 1924 ustanovili Alpski varstveni park, Belarja ni bilo zraven. Po 1. svetovni vojni so ga po krivici ožigosali za germanofila, kar je takrat pomenilo zanesljiv izbris iz javnega življenja. Po zaplembi seizmološkega observatorija mu je ljubljanski magistrat leta 1919 poslal še odločbo o odpovedi stanovanja z enomesečnim rokom izpraznitve. Njegova žena in otroci so bili primorani emigrirati v Ameriko, njemu pa so to preprečili in odvzeli potni list.

Izgubljen stik z družino in materialna beda so mu leta 1930 nakopali hudo bolezen. Preselil

se je k znancem na Kočevsko, toda psihični pretresi, posledice hude sladkorne bolezni s paralizirano udov, oglušlostjo in slepoto so leta 1939 končali žalostno zgodbo idejnega očeta Triglavskega narodnega parka, ko je daleč od svojcev umrl pozabljen ter popolnoma obubožan.

V spomin Albinu Belarju je Javni zavod Triglavski narodni park v Podhomu odkril spominsko obeležje, podeljuje Belarjeva priznanja in vsako leto za osnovnošolce organizira Belarjeve naravoslovne dneve v Trenti.



*Following the establishment of the world's first national park in the Yellowstone Valley, USA, in 1872, other similar initiatives to protect pristine nature in the Alps were dismissed as mere folly in the prevailing opinion of the time.*

*Dr. Albin Belar, a distinguished seismologist and inventor was at the forefront of this new wave in nature conservation in the province of Carniola. By 1906, he had elaborated an expert catalogue for the Provincial Administration of Carniola, proposing the recognition of the Ljubljana Marshes, the Triglav Lakes Valley, Snežnik and the Krakovski*

*gozd area as natural monuments. Two years later, he crafted the proposal for the establishment of a Nature Conservation Park above the Komarča cliff (in the Triglav Lakes Valley).*

*When the Alpine Conservation Park was formed in Ljubljana in 1924, Dr. Belar was notably absent. After World War I, he was unfairly branded as being pro-German, which prompted complete exclusion from public life at the time. His seismological observatory was confiscated and in 1919, the Ljubljana Magistrate served him an eviction notice with a one-month deadline to vacate his flat. His family were forced to emigrate to America, but Belar was prevented from doing the same and stripped of his passport in the process.*

*Devastated by the loss of family and by financial struggles, Belar fell seriously ill in 1930. He moved in with his friends in the Kočevje region, but the psychological trauma and the effects of severe diabetes eventually left him paralyzed, partially deaf, and blind. The tragic story of the 'father' of Triglav National Park ended in 1939, when Albin Belar passed away, far from his family, forgotten and destitute.*

*In honor of Albin Belar's legacy, Triglav National Park has unveiled a memorial plaque in Podhom. It also bestows Belar awards, and annually hosts Belar Days (natural science days) in Trenta for elementary school students.*
